## APRIL 12, 2009

- **Over the years we have hosted numerous community groups at our Parish Center.** Most recently we have begun offering our Life House or Parish Hall for **funeral receptions** for our parishioners. We provide a place to meet, table covers and centerpieces at a time when a family is grieving. This is one less detail to which a family member needs to attend.
  - **The Comfort Food Ministry** was established to bring food and comfort to those who are in need of meals due to illness in the family, the birth of a child, or a death in the family. If you, or someone you know, would benefit from this ministry, or if you would like to join our team of dedicated volunteers, please contact us and we will be happy to provide you with information.
  - **Prayer Shawl Ministry** is a group of people that come together once a month in prayer to create beautifully unique shawls, lap robes and throws for those who are in need of comfort or simple proof that we are not alone in this world. We receive names of "honorees" from friends who want to share God's love in times of need. Our members prayerfully knit or crochet the item, which is blessed for each person individually before it is given to them. We have touched approximately 115 people through this giving program since our inception here last June. We also welcome into our St Mary's Family our newest members, when upon their Baptism, they receive a handmade Baptismal Blanket that is blessed for each one separately. This part of our program started just this past January and we've already given out over 160 Baptismal Blankets! All are welcome to join and also encouraged to think about enrolling someone's name who can be added to our "Honoree's List."
  - Each month the parish provides **Living With Christ** to our daily mass goers so that they can take the "Word of God" with them.
  - **Our ARISE** small communities are thriving. The books and CDs for the ARISE process are purchased by the parish so that no financial burden is incurred by those who participate.
  - This year during Lent, volunteers prepared food that the parish provided so that those who came to pray together the Stations of the Cross could stay and enjoy lunch together.
  - For more than 25 years the parish has been the site of **St. Mary's Prayer Group**, providing a worship space on Tuesday nights and a priest or deacon to celebrate Mass or a Eucharistic Service.
  - Through St. Vincent de Paul and volunteer staffing of the Food Pantry, we reach out to those in our community who may be in need especially during these difficult economic times. Let us continue to work together so that we may truly be an "Alleluia!" people.
