all night event.



Click on the St Mary's on line Giving Link.

Click on "Sign up for a New Account"

Follow the instruction on the screen:

User ID: Your User ID must be between 6 and 12 characters and contain at least one alpha and one numeric character. e.g.: **jsmith5**

Password: Your Password must be between 8 and 16 characters and contain at least one alpha, one numeric and one special character (!@&*).

e.g.: **p@ssword5**

Once you fill out the form and submit: you will receive an email containing a link that you must click in order to activate your account. Once you have successfully validated your email address you may then login.
