The new system will be state of the art and ultra efficient. In the end it will save the parish money in the years to come.

Unfortunately the situation dictates that we raise this money in addition to what everyone is already giving. I wish to thank all of you for your generosity in helping to maintain the parish. Many times people say, "Father, if you need something, just ask"; well I need to ask again. In light of this, this weekend we will have a second collection. In the months ahead we are forced to add this monthly collection so as to spread out the payments of this debt.
