On July, 11<sup>th</sup> there will be a collection for Black and Native American. Your support would be appreciated.

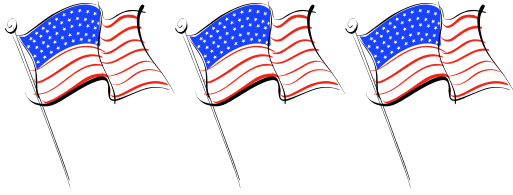
### **RCIA-The Rite for Christian Initiation of Adults**
